CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Competitors must be in school years 7 or below, or years 8 or 9. Players cannot enter the same discipline in the two age groups, however they can do one in each e.g. Singles in Year 7 and below, Doubles in Year 8 & 9.
2. This tournament is intended for inexperienced players who don't compete regularly, therefore the following restrictions will apply:
 - Players who are members of a current or previous season's county badminton squad may not to enter.
 - Players who have played in a Badminton England junior circuit event and won two or more matches in a single discipline at the same tournament are not eligible to enter.

4. All competitors must complete an entry form.
5. Entry deadline is midnight on 3rd November. Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the tournament secretary.
6. All events will be played in groups, followed by a knockout. A consolation event may be run if numbers and time allows.
7. Feather shuttles will be used.
8. Prizes will be awarded to all finalists.
9. FastStep Badminton Academy can accept no liability for injury or loss, however caused.
10. Entries will be acknowledged by email.
11. Start times will be emailed to competitors a few days before the event. It is anticipated that the event will start at 9am and finish by 5pm. Not all competitors will be required for the whole day.
12. If unable to attend after entry, please inform the Tournament Secretary immediately by email andrew@faststepbadminton.co.uk or on the tournament day by phone 07590080998. Refunds can only be offered if you withdraw more than 24 hours before the tournament starts.
13. Players should arrive 15 minutes before their start time and register immediately.
14. Players must wear appropriate badminton clothing and clean non-marking trainers.
15. In the event of a tie in a group, the winner will be decided by the following criteria in this order until a winner is determined. Most games won, greatest points difference, head to head.
16. Places in the tournament are limited and offered on a first-come first-served basis.
17. The tournament referee's decision is final on all matters. The referee reserves the right to make changes to the format if required and if in the best interests of the tournament.

NOTES REGARDING THE VENUE

1. There is ample free parking at the venue.
2. Some refreshments will be available but you are advised to bring a picnic lunch if you are scheduled to play in the middle of the day.
3. There are limited seats in the sports hall, so spectators are advised to bring camping chairs to sit on.
